**18-26: The Trauma Sensitive Classroom:** Social Emotional Learning and Trauma-Informed Schools are popular buzz words, but what do we really know about fostering a positive learning environment when so often students seem to be emotional, reactive, frustrated, and excitable?

This workshop will include helping teachers care for themselves AND THEN their students by working to create a Trauma Sensitive Classroom.

**18-21: Infographics... Teach Your Students How to Display Information in Exciting New Ways:** Tired of the boring old PowerPoint Presentation? Infographics are an interesting way to visually display information, data or knowledge clearly. Infographics are a visual representation of data. When students create infographics, they are using information, visual, and technology literacies. Teachers can develop formative or summative assessments that have students creating infographics to showcase their mastery of knowledge. In this session, participants will learn how to create infographics using a variety of technologies and explore how to use this strategy to enhance teaching and learning. We will also look at an infographic rubric to discuss quality. Each participant will develop his or her own infographic activity to share.

**18-23: G Suite & Microsoft Compatibles:** This is your introduction to G Suite. Learn how to use Microsoft Compatible programs (Word, Excel, and PowerPoint) offered to you in G Suite, as well as how to upload your files to a safe cloud based storage option. You will also learn how to share and collaborate using your G Suite account. In addition, we will learn how to use Calendar and Keep.
