<b>Code 15</b> Professional Salaries	<b>Budgeted: \$598,190</b> We are also keeping class sizes lower by keeping a PE teacher, Music Teacher, and Art teacher that would otherwise be removed. But with the learning loss we want to keep sizes lower so that students have a lower teacher to student ratio in the electives and fine arts that will help promote mental health. Another hire is the LAN Tech- this position will be used to ensure our technology needs are kept up to date and allows us to be prepared for any remote switch that could take place at any moment. This also frees up our technology director to implement new classroom offers for the students. And finally we hired a school psychologist because we believe that the mental health of our students is one of the biggest problems that has resulted from the pandemic and we want to be able to access and early intervention any mental health developments as a result. So with an additional mental health staff member we can address more students needs from Pre-K- 12.

<b>Code 40</b> Purchased Services	<b>Budgeted: \$568,104</b> As a district we believe that training our staff will give them the tools necessary to help curb the learning loss. We are focusing this money on PLC training, professional development for staff, and investing in responsive classroom to give our teachers the tools to identify student weaknesses and the abilities to address them. The district is utilizing this money to be able to construct an outdoor learning space which will allow for 4 additional outdoor learning classrooms. We are also replacing the HVAC system in our library to be a better filtration system and better air quality for our staff and students. We are also updating all of our water fountains to be touchless water bottle fillers as well as water fountains so that we can combat the spread of germs and keep our facilities cleaner for our staff and students.
