Dear families,

Governor Hochul announced today that the school mask mandate will be ending on March 2, 2022. As such we will be following the mask mandate for Monday, February 28, and Tuesday, March 1, 2022. Although I am not certain why there is a two day period in which masks are required, cooperation for the next 2 school days will be greatly appreciated.

As masking will now become optional, any staff or student that chooses to wear one will be able to do so. We will continue to provide masks at each of our entrances for students and staff that will choose to wear them. We also have a supply of cotton masks that are available for those members of our school community that prefer that style. Please stop in at any of our school offices and we will ensure you get a mask that you are comfortable with.
